Tamborine Mountain Scout Group is situated on approximately 4 acres of land at 127 Hartley Road, Tamborine Mountain.

The Group's Heritage Den was moved to its current location in June 2021, and is over 100 years old. Recent additional building works included the bitumen carpark, Quartermaster's Store, Den roof replacement and new kitchen. Plans are underway for an undercover shelter with camp kitchen.

The Group is a member of the Tamborine Mountain Sports Association, which provides access to the facilities located within the adjacent Tamborine Mountain Sports Centre, including change rooms with showers, and a commercial kitchen.

Further conditions apply regarding access to these facilities if required.

Please note that members of the public may attempt to enter the campgrounds, as the local parkrun circuit includes the outer boundaries. Our Group provides basic signage to advise when a Scout activity is in progress, however Leader vigilance is advised.

CONDITIONS FOR ALL HIRERS

- Consumption of alcohol and smoking (includes e-cigarettes) are prohibited on site
- No loud noise permitted after 9:00pm and before 7:00am. Please be respectful of our neighbours. Inappropriate behaviour may result in removal from our site
- Care is to be taken when travelling on Hartley Road. This is a narrow residential street with limited lighting
- No pets permitted on site
- No generators permitted on site

CAMPSITE CHECKLIST

ON ARRIVAL:

- Obtain den key from Group representative

DURING CAMP:

- This location operates on tank water; all hirers are required to bring their own drinking water supply
- The toilets operate on a site-specific sewerage system; no foreign matter is to be placed into the toilets or kitchen sink
- All hirers are required to bring their own cooking equipment, gas supply etc.
- All hirers are required to bring their own first aid kit
- Enjoy your camping experience

CAMPFIRES:

- There is a designated campfire pit located immediately south of the Den. All campfires are to be conducted in this pit
- No rubbish is to be burned in the campfire
- Groups will be required to supply their own water to extinguish their campfire
- Groups will be required to bring their own logs for burning however kindling is likely to be available in the surrounding bush land

RUBBISH:

- All rubbish is required to be removed by the hirer
- All recyclable items are to be placed into the Scout Recycling Centre wheelie bins

ON DEPARTURE:

- Ensure all areas of the Den, including toilets, are cleaned. Cleaning products are located within the kitchen storeroom.
- Ensure Den is locked and keys returned
- Liaise with Group representative to confirm numbers for invoicing
